



## RISK ASSESSMENT - COVID 19

CONCERN	CONTROL MEASURES
Is the space large enough and well-ventilated to accommodate the size of your group allowing for 2m distance?	The group is limited to 7 participants. Each child will have a chair in their own 'pod', marked out on the floor with tape at 2m distance from each other. There is a fire exit door at the back of the room which will be open throughout the session. Ensuring a 2m distance means that singing is allowed.
Are there sufficient handwashing facilities?	The community centre has toilet facilities and provides hand sanitiser which the tutor and children will use as they come in.
Are surfaces and instruments clean prior to club?	The tutor will wipe down surfaces, spare ukuleles, stands and tuners with anti-bac wipes before and after each session. Children will be shown how to clean their own ukulele at the start of the club - in case the tutor needs to handle it to help with tuning.
Have children got their own ukulele?	Parents are advised to buy a ukulele for their child to avoid sharing of instruments. Where this isn't possible the instruments will be cleaned with anti-bac wipes before and after use.
Is everyone feeling well?	If the tutor feels unwell on the day of the club the tutor will cancel the club by phoning parents. Sessions cancelled due to the tutor being unwell or self-isolating will be rescheduled. Please do not come to the session if you or your child is not feeling well. Sessions missed due to the child being unwell cannot be refunded, but resources from the session will

	be emailed to the parent.
Parent breaking six person rule while waiting	Tutor will meet children at the door on arrival, parents asked to meet children at the door at the end. Stay 1m apart while waiting. The Cottage pub is opposite if you wish to have a coffee, etc while waiting
Is the tutor up to date on latest government guidelines?	Tutors receive regular updates from Soundsense (association for community musicians) and the Musician's Union.
